"How do you know that the Bais Hamikdash was destroyed?" asked the Yid


"Because of the strange noise that the cow made," answered the Arab.

Rabbai Yehoshua was so happy to hear that Moshiach was coming that day, that he quickly ran to tell Eliyahu Hanovi.


The day passed and Moshiach did not arrive. Reb Yehoshua said to Eliyahu Hanovi: "Moshiach said he was coming today and he hasn't come."





Rabbi Yonathan was a very wise Rabbi whom all the Jews admired and liked. The Goyim also admired his great wisdom. 
All the ministers did as Rabbi Yonathan asked.


The ministers saw how clever Rabbi Yonathan was and they all laughed.

Many years ago there lived in Russia a very great Rabbi. Once, at one of his Sedorim on Pesach, he had a Jewish soldier from the Russian army as a guest. The soldier was a very simple man who did not know how to learn Torah or how to daven. During the whole seder the soldier kept quiet. When the seder was nearly over and the people began to sing the songs at the back of the Hagadda, the soldier heard them say the words "Peduyim L'Zion B'rina."


The soldier heard the people singing this Possuk and he started to dance and sing with them. He sang in Russian in a very loud voice: "Poydyum L'Zion B'rina" (Poydyum in Russian means "Let's Go!")

The soldier went to the door and started dancing as he went out the room. The Rabbi was also very happy and he started dancing and said: "We are ready!!! We are ready to go to Zion!!"

WAITING FOR MOSHIACH EVERY DAY!!!!!

The Tzadik, Reb Levi Yitschok of Berditchov waited for Moshiach every day.

Reb Levi Yitschok was very upset about all the troubles that the Jews had in Golus. He wanted the final redemption to come, so that Moshiach could save the Yidden from their troubles.

Reb Levi Yitschok was so sure that Moshiach was going to come at any minute, that before he went to bed at night he put his Shabbos clothes next to the door. When Moshiach comes, he thought, I won't have to waste time looking for my Shabbos clothes, but I will be able to get dressed quickly and go up to Jerusalem with Moshiach.

Reb Levi Yitschok would stand next to the window a few times a day to check and see if Moshiach had already arrived.

When Reb Levi Yitschok married off his grandson, he wrote in the invitation:

THE KADKOD STONES (precious stones) Yalkut Shimoni on Yeshayahu 54

The Novi Yeshayahu wrote, that during the times of Moshiach, the windows in Jerusalem would be made out of precious stones called "Kadkod stones". Some wise men sat in a Yeshiva in Lod and thought about these Kadkod stones. They wondered what they could possibly be. Reb Yehoshua ben Levi was one of these wise men, and he asked Eliyahu Hanovi to show him what this Kadkod stone looked like. Eliyahu Hanovi promised to perform a miracle and show him these precious stones.

At the same time a boy was sailing in a boat to Eretz Yisrael. When the boat was in the middle of the sea, a great storm broke out. In the middle of the storm Eliyahu Hanovi revealed himself to the boy and said: "I will give you some Kadkod stones, and you will take them to the city of Lod and show them to Reb Yehoshua ben Levi. Because of this good deed that you do for me I will save you and all the people from drowning."

The boy answered: "Reb Yehoshua ben Levi is a great rabbi. He will not believe that you sent me to him."

Eliyahu Hanovi said to him: "Reb Yehoshua is a very humble man. He will believe you and he will listen to what you have to say. Take the Kadkod stones, but do not look at them at all. Do not show them to anyone. Take them directly to Reb Yehoshua. When you arrive in the city of Lod, ask Reb Yehoshua to take you to a dark cave near the city of Lod. Only when you get there may you show him the stones."

Eliyahu Hanovi gave the boy the stones and he put them in his pocket without looking at them.

The storm stopped and the boat reached Eretz Yisrael safely. The boy left the boat and went to the city of Lod to the Yeshiva of Reb Yehoshua ben Levi. The boy asked Reb Yehoshua to come with him to a cave when it got dark. Once they were in the cave the boy took out the stones to show them to Reb Yehoshua and then he told him that Eliyahu Hanovi had sent him. When the boy opened his hand, the stones shone so brightly, that the whole cave was lit up. The light shone so brightly that it shone all the way to Lod.

REB MOSHE DID NOT MANAGE TO BRING MOSHIACH

Reb Moshe was a great Tzadik who lived in Poland. Reb Moshe decided that he had to go to Eretz Yisrael in order to bring Moshiach. Reb Moshe went from city to city collecting money to pay for his transport to get to Eretz Yisrael. When I arrive in Eretz Yisrael, he thought, I will go straight to the Kottel and I will not rest or keep quiet until Moshiach comes.


Reb Moshe and ten of his Chassidim got on a boat to sail to Eretz Yisrael. When Reb Moshe arrived on the shores of Eretz Yisrael, he was so excited. He had nearly arrived in the holy city of Jerusalem. He would go straight to the Kottel and daven for Moshiach to come right now.


A few days later, Reb Moshe and his Chassidim arrived in Jerusalem. As soon as his feet touched the ground of Jerusalem, something happened... His very precious Kiddush cup fell to the ground and broke into a million pieces. This Kiddush cup had been given to him by his rabbi when he became a big rabbi himself and he was so upset. Reb Moshe had wanted to use this cup to perform great miracles when he got to the Kottel. Reb Moshe became so sick that he was unable to walk to the Kottel.

Reb Moshe felt that there was a reason that this had happened. When he became even sicker and he knew that he was dying, he called his sons to him and asked them to take him to the Kottel, in his bed.

'Quickly!" he said "take me to the Kottel right now, before it is too late!"

The boys did as they were told. They lifted up the bed and started to carry Reb Moshe to the Kottel. On the way they had to stop because Arabs were throwing stones at them. There was no way that they could continue walking to the Kottel. They had no choice but to return from where they had come, taking Reb Moshe with them. Reb Moshe felt that all his efforts had failed to bring Moshiach, and because he was so upset about it, he died on that very same day.





WHAT WONDERFUL THINGS WILL HAPPEN WHEN MOSHIACH COMES?

Here are a few of the wonderful things that will happen.

- * The wonderful things that are going to happen will be even greater than when the Yidden came out of Mitzrayim (Egypt). Micha 7,15
- * People's lives will be very easy, they will live for thousands of years. (Rambam) When there is "Techiyas Hameysim" (when all the dead people will come alive), then they will live for ever. (Ramban)
- * The Jews will not have to look after their flocks, the non-Jews will do it for them; and then the Jews can learn Torah peacefully all day long. (Yeshaya 61,5)
- * Women will give birth to babies everyday. (Shabbos 30, 72)
- * If Bnei Yisrael will be Tzadikim and worthy, then they will all go to Eretz Yisrael on clouds. (Daniel 7,13)
- * All Bnei Israel will be prophets, small children and even servants. 9 Yoel 2,1-2)
- * Hashem will make a feast for all the Tzadikim and He will sit at the head of the table. The Heavenly Spirits will bring to the feast lots of different spices from Gan Eden. (Vayikra Rabba 13)
- * At this feast that Hashem makes for the Tzadikim, they will eat the meat of the Livyatan, (the whale that was created during the six days of creation.) From the skin of the Livyatan, Hashem will make a Succah for the Tzadikim. (Baba Batra 75,71)
- * Anyone who is careful in keeping the mitzva of Tzitzit will have 2800 non-Jewish servants who will serve him. (Shabbat 32,72)

- * From the ground in the land of Israel, will sprout cakes and clothes made of silk. (Ketuvot 111,72)
- * The fruit trees will bear new fruit every day. (Shabbat 3, 72)
- * On the same day that the seeds are sown, the fruit will grow and one will be able to eat it. Just like during the time of Adam Harishon (the first man). One will also be able to eat the tree itself as well as the fruit. (Torat Kohanim on Vayikra 26,4)
- * The wheat will grow very tall, as tall as date trees on the top of mountains. Hashem will send a wind which will cause the kernels to fall out from the stalk of wheat. (Ketuvot 111,72)
- * Each kernel of wheat will be as big as an ox's kidney. (Ketuvot 11, 72)
- * Every berry will be so big that it will have to be carried by boat or wagon. (Ketuvot 111, 72)
- * Each vine will be so big that it will take an entire city of people to pick one. The wine that will be made from the grapes will be so delicious that old and young people will enjoy drinking it. (Ketuvot 111, 72)
- * All fruitless trees (trees that can't bear fruit) will give fruit. (End of Masechet Ketuvot)
- * A wolf will be able to live with a lamb without causing it any harm. A calf will be able to live with a lion, and a small boy will rule over them. (Yeshayahu 11 6-8)
- * The wolf and the lamb will pasture together in the field. The lion will no longer roar he will eat straw like all the other animals. (Yeshayahu 65, 25)
- * Hashem will dry up the Euphrates river and from it Hashem will make 7 rivers and paths so that the 7 exiles can pass through to go to Eretz Yisrael, (Yeshayahu 11, 15-16)

- * Hashem will create a new Heaven and a new Earth. (Yeshayahu 65, 17 Rashi)
- * The light of the moon will be as bright as the sun is now. The sun will shine 343 times brighter than it does today.

(Pesachim 65, 71)

- * Hashem will bring massive precious stones. Each one will be made into a gate by Hashem and will be placed in the walls of Jerusalem. (Baba Batra 75,71)
- * The whole area of Jerusalem will be filled with precious stones and pearls Anyone who wants to will be able to come and take. If two people fight over money, and then they come to be judged by Melech Hamoshiach, they see when they will arrive in Jerusalem all the precious stones and all the pearls. They will take what they need and they won't need to be judged. (Yalkut Shimoni 55, remez 478)
- * From Beit Hamikdash will come a river. In the river will be many delicious foods. The fruits from the river will be eaten, and the leaves will be used to make medicines for all kinds of illnesses (Sanhadrin 100, 81)
- * All the Goyim will come to the Beit Hamikdash to learn about the correct way to serve Hashem. (Yeshayahu 2, 2-3)
- * The Goyim will change their swords into working tools. They will no longer fight among themselves and they will only know peace. (Yeshayahu)

HILCHOS MELECH HAMOSHIACH

Taken from: Hilchos Melachim B'Rambam Chapter 11

Hilchos teshuva Chapter 9, Halacha 2

WHAT WILL MELECH HAMOSHIACH DO?

Melech Hamoshiach will bring back the kingdom of King David like it was in the times of Dovid Hamelech, He will rebuild the Beis Hamikdash and bring all the Yidden back to Eretz Yisrael.

When Moshiach comes we will be able to keep all the Mitzvos in the Torah, even those that we were not able to keep when we were in Golus. We will be able to offer sacrifices, keep Shmitta and Yovel and do everything just as it is written in the Torah.

HOW MUCH DO WE HAVE TO BELIEVE IN MOSHIACH?

Whoever does not believe in Moshiach, or wait for his arrival - is like one who denies the Torah, Moshe Rabainu and the Prophets.

WILL MOSHIACH HAVE TO PERFORM GREAT MIRACLES?

Don't think that as soon as Moshiach reveals himself he will have to perform great miracles and revive the dead, because even if we cannot see these wonderous miracles we will be able to recognize him according to the signs mentioned in the Torah.

WHAT ARE THE SIGNS OF MELECH HAMOSHIACH?

If we see a great leader who is descended from Dovid Hamelech, and who learns Torah and is busy with Mitzvos like Dovid Hamelech, one who follows the Torah Sh'Bichtav (the written Torah), one who is busy influencing other Jews to keep Torah and Mitzvos, one who fights the wars of Hashem (fighting for what Hashem wants), such a person, according to Halacha (Jewish law) is the Moshiach.

WHEN WILL WE KNOW FOR SURE THAT THIS MOSHIACH IS GOING TO BRING THE FINAL REDEMPTION?

If this Moshaich has managed to persuade Yidden to do Teshuva (repentance) and G-d fearing Jews, built the Bais Hamikdosh and brought all the Yidden to Eretz Yisrael, then for sure this person is Moshiach. He is the one who the Torah speakes about. Moshiach will also fix the whole world. He will make all nations believe in Hashem.

THE DAYS OF MOSHIACH From Hilchos Melochim in Rambam chapter 12

WILL THE WORLD CHANGE WHEN MOSHIACH COMES?

Do not think that as soon as Moshiach comes the world will change. The world will continue in the same way as it is now, until the time comes for Moshiach to bring the complete redemption. Only then will there be great miracles.

WHAT WILL BE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THIS WORLD AND THE WORLD WHEN MOSHIACH COMES?

Our chachamim tell us that the only difference between this world and the world when Moshiach is here will be that when Moshiach comes the Yidden will no longer be under the rule of the Goyim.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN BEFORE MOSHIACH COMES?

There are things written in the Torah, but chachamim have not decided how and when these things will take place. For example, at the beginning of the days of Moshiach there will be a big war that is called "The War of Gog U'Magog". Before that war, Eliyahu Hanovi will come and tell us that Moshiach is coming to bring the final redemption. Eliyahu Hanovi will also prepare the hearts of the Yidden, as it is written: "Behold I am sending to you Eliyahu Hanovi, before the great and feared day of Hashem arrives." Our sages however, are not sure when these things will happen. One thing is understood, that the purpose of Eliyahu Hanovi coming is to bring peace into the world.

MELECH HAMOSHIACH WILL TELL EVERYONE WHICH SHEVET (TRIBE) THEY COME FROM.

When Moshiach comes all the Yidden will gather before him and through Ruach Hakodesh he will tell everyone which shevet (tribe) they belong to. First he will tell those from shevet Levi who is a Kohen and who is a Levi. However, he will not tell anyone whether they are from a Kosher family or if he is a slave.

WHY ARE OUR CHACHAMIM WAITING SO EAGERLY FOR THE DAYS OF MOSHIACH?

The reason that our chachamim are waiting so eagerly for Moshiach is not so that they can rule over the whole world, nor that the Goyim will honour and respect them. It is not because they

want to eat and drink and be merry. They are waiting for Moshiach so that they will be free to learn Torah without anyone bothering them and then they will merit the world to come.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN WHEN MOSHIACH COMES?

When Moshiach comes there will be no famine and no war, no jealousy or competition. There will be abundance and all good foods will be as many as the dust of the earth. Everyone will be busy with gaining knowledge about Hashem. The Yidden will be wise knowing great secrets about the Torah, as it is written: "The world will be filled with the knowledge of Hashem."



WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO SOMEONE WHO WAS BLIND OR DEAF?

Everyone will arise from the dead in the same way that he was in this world. After he has arisen, Hashem will heal him. Everyone will still be wearing the same clothes that he wore in this world.

WHO WILL ARISE FIRST IN TECHIYAS HAMAISIM?

First those who were buried in Eretz Yisrael, and thereafter those who were buried in other countries.

HOW WILL HASHEM REBUILD THE BODIES OF THE DEAD PEOPLE?

The body will be built from one bone. This bone is called the "Luz Bone." When a person dies and he is buried, this bone does not decay. From that bone Hashem will rebuild the person's body. When one eats at a Melava Malka on a Motsei Shabbos, he strengthens this Luz Bone.
